Chinook's Edge is committed to ensuring students have a good experience at school, and we are intentional about understanding what that experience is and how we can improve it. We are pleased to share that we've seen some growth in key areas, according to our latest survey

A message from Superintendent Kurt Sacher

Chinook's Edge recently surveyed parents, staff and students in grades 4 to 12. A summary of the results are in the graphic on the left.

We are especially pleased to see that satisfaction with the level of parent involvement in their child's education was at 93% for parents. That represents more than a 10 percent increase from last year's survey.

Our schools and our staff were intentional about welcoming families into schools this year. We are grateful for that work because we know it impacts student success. Also, thank you to you as parents for responding and for engaging with your child's education.

We have also taken note of what we heard in the survey about attendance. While a majority of parents do not believe attendance is an issue, one in four parents are concerned about it. The survey results point to anxiety as the major consideration impacting student attendance. Chinook's Edge will continue to focus on what we can do to help families and, in particular, our students. We know that when students are in the classroom and ready to learn, their engagement in their learning and their long-term success increases significantly. Thank you for doing all that you can do as parents to ensure that your child attends regularly.

Thank you to parents, students and staff who participated in the survey. Your feedback is incredibly important as we strive to ensure a positive experience for students at school.

A note about Junior High exams:

As an external motivator we are implementing an exemption policy for junior high exams. Students need to learn to study, to review and to show their learning in a variety of ways. One assessment tool we use is final exams.

Junior high students will receive an exemption from their final exam in a course where they have achieved a cumulative grade at 80% or above. If they have over 80% in more than one course they can choose which exam they wish to be exempted from. They may be exempted from only one exam and it has to be in a course where they reached the 80% or above. They will be informed two weeks prior to exams as to which courses they have the option to be exempted from.

Why?

Chinook's Edge Staff are planning ahead for the upcoming year.

In mid-August, Chinook's Edge will be sending home your "Annual Re-Enrollment and Consents" for the 2023-2024 year, this form is replacing the Annual Demographic Update.

This form will need to be completed and submitted prior to the start of the school year.

The form will ensure your registration and certain consents for the upcoming school year.

The form contains a Walking Field Trip, Technology, Media and FOIP consents that has to be completed every year before your child can participate in these activities. We have combined some forms together into one to make the start of the school year a little easier for you.

We are asking parents and guardians to ensure that they can **sign into their Powerschool parent portal account before the end of the year.** If you are having troubles with your username or password, please contact your Mrs.

Bellerive before the end of May to get help.
