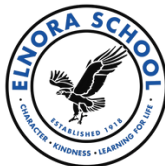
Thank you also for taking the time to complete the school surveys. Your feedback is helping us plan and make Elnora School even better for our students next year.

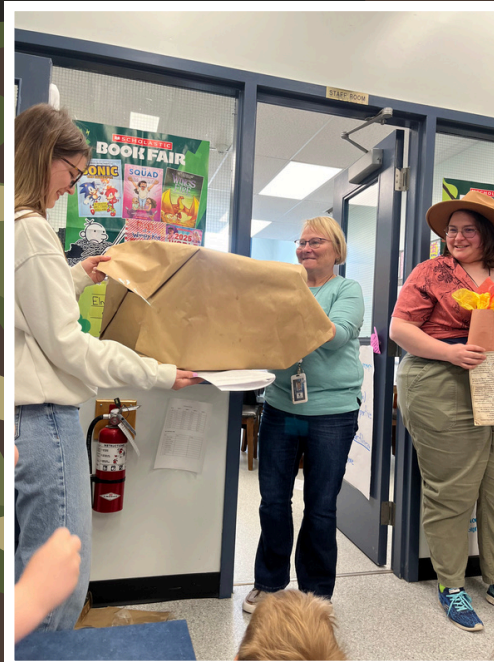
